- 2. Chromosomes determine how we all look and grow
- 3. There are 3 types of Down syndrome
- 4. Trisomy 21 is when there are 3 copies of the 21st chromosome
- 5. Translocation Down syndrome is when a 3rd copy of the 21st chromosome attaches to another
- 6. Mosaic Down syndrome is when only some of the cells in a body have 3 copies of the 21st chromosome
- 7. Down syndrome is NOT contagious; you cannot catch it
- 8. People with Down syndrome have feelings, just like you and me
- 9. People with Down syndrome can fall in love and get married
- 10. Sometimes it takes a longer time for people with Down syndrome to learn new skills
- 11. People with Down syndrome want to be treated like everyone else
- 12. People with Down syndrome are unique with their own thoughts and talents
- 13. Sometimes having Down syndrome makes it more difficult to move and talk
- 14. Sometimes people with Down syndrome have hearing impairments, and may use a device to help them hear. They also might know American Sign Language
